SUBJECT: Iraq Coalition Update

- You asked for an update on coalition support for Iraq.
- Overall, 33 countries may be said to be currently in the "Coalition." (Tab A)
- 25 countries have agreed to provide access, basing, and overflight.
- 3 countries have offered military forces, which are integrated into CENTCOM's planning:
  - [REDACTED] FA-18s; SAS Troops; 2 Frigates & 1 Landing Platform Assault Ship; C2 Contingent in [REDACTED] Multiple C130s
  - [REDACTED] - OEF NBC Unit in [REDACTED] (unit increased by 107 personnel effectively doubling the unit's capacity)
  - [REDACTED] Combat Division, [REDACTED] Squadrons, Aircraft Carrier, SF Forces
- Military representatives of 6 countries have identified specific forces to CENTCOM; however, their government have not yet made the political decision to make those forces available:
